School Uniform / Gwisg yr Ysgol

School Uniform is compulsory for all pupils and must be worn on the way to and from school as well as on the school site.

Girls / Merched

- ✓ Navy box pleated knee length skirt with navy tights or
- ✓ Navy tailored trousers (not skinny-fit)
- ✓ Blue blouse (loose not fitted)
- ✓ Plain navy V neck sweater bearing school badge
- ✓ School tie
- ✓ Black shoes (no trainers)
- ✓ Plain black or navy outer coat (no hoodies, denim or leather jackets)
- ✓ Plain black or navy hat, scarves and gloves
- ✓ Waterproof rucksack

Boys / Bechgyn

- ✓ Dark grey trousers
- ✓ Blue shirt
- ✓ Plain navy V neck sweater bearing school badge
- ✓ School tie
- ✓ Black shoes (no trainers)
- ✓ Plain black or navy outer coat (no hoodies, denim or leather jackets)
- ✓ Plain black or navy hat, scarves and gloves
- ✓ Waterproof rucksack

- Shoes must be flat – heels are unsafe in school. To travel around a large campus in inclement weather, pupils are expected to wear sensible shoes. **The wearing of training shoes or boots of any description is not permitted.**
- Fashion handbags are not appropriate for school.
- Corduroy, denim and tight skinny-fit trousers are not acceptable.
- Jewellery – one watch and one small plain metal stud earring per ear are the only pieces of jewellery allowed. **No other jewellery is permitted.** All jewellery must be removed for P.E./games lessons. **The school cannot accept responsibility for items of jewellery worn to school.**
- No make-up or nail varnish should be worn in school by pupils.
- Hair must be of one natural colour. No form of ‘cult’ hairstyle is countenanced at this school; e.g. tramlines, exceptionally short shaved hair, partings shaved into hair, mohicans etc. Parents are strongly advised to seek the advice on the acceptability of hairstyles that may be considered ‘different’ or ‘cult’ before allowing their child to adopt such a style.

The uniform as printed above is constant throughout Years 7 to 11.
