Support Available

There is a lot of support out there for Young Carers. If you are caring for someone at home, go to see your Head of Learning and Skills and they can arrange support to help you. You can get involved with the Young Carers Project where you can get an opportunity to have a break from your caring responsibilities. You will be able to get involved in social and leisure activities and will be given practical and emotional support. The important thing is that you don't have to go through this alone.
