

## Sixth Form Uniform

### BOYS' UNIFORM

Mid-grey trousers (not black)  
White shirt  
Plain V-neck **burgundy** sweater  
Sixth Form school tie  
Black shoes (no boots or trainers)  
A plain dark outer coat – black or navy (no grey)  
Waterproof rucksack

### GIRLS' UNIFORM

Mid-grey **knee length pleated** skirt with black/ grey tights  
or  
Mid-grey tailored trousers with black/grey socks  
White blouse (not tailored or open-necked)  
Plain V-neck **burgundy** sweater  
Sixth Form school tie  
Black shoes (no boots or trainers)  
A plain dark outer coat – black or navy (no grey)  
Waterproof rucksack

The Sixth Form tie can be purchased from the approved stores.

**It is expected that all Sixth Form Students have the Sixth Form BURGUNDY (not red) sweaters which can be purchased from the approved stores.**

**School Uniform is compulsory for all pupils and must be worn on the way to and from school as well as on the school site.**

- Shoes should be flat – heels are unsafe in school. Because of the necessity of travelling around a very large campus in inclement weather, pupils are expected to wear sensible shoes. The wearing of training shoes or boots of any description is not permitted.
- Fashion handbags are not appropriate for school.
- Leather coats, denim jackets and **hooded tops of any kind** are not acceptable. Hooded sweatshirts are to be worn only for P.E.
- Hats and scarves must be plain black or navy. No baseball hats are permitted.
- Corduroy and denim trousers are not acceptable.
- Jewellery – one watch and one plain gold or silver stud earring per ear are the only pieces of jewellery allowed. **No other jewellery is permitted.** All jewellery must be removed for P.E./games lessons. **The school cannot accept responsibility for items of jewellery worn to school.**
- Hair must be of one natural colour. No form of 'cult' hairstyles on pupils is countenanced at this school and parents are strongly advised to seek advice on the acceptability of hairstyles that may be considered 'different' before allowing their child to adopt such a style.
