

## OUR UNIFORM AND APPEARANCE / EIN GWISG A GOLWG

School Uniform and appearance guidelines are compulsory for all students, on the way to and from school as well as on the school site. Due to health and safety issues in practical subjects in particular, hair and nails need to be safe and suitable for a work environment. Students may apply natural make-up if they wish to do so.

- Dark grey trousers (not skinny fit trousers)
- Blue shirt
- School tie
- Navy V neck school sweater
- Plain black footwear (waterproof)
- Plain black or navy waterproof outer coat (no hoodies, denim or leather jackets)
- Plain black, grey or navy hat, scarf and gloves
- Waterproof rucksack



## JEWELLERY / GEMWAITH

One watch and one plain gold or silver stud earring per ear are the only pieces of jewellery allowed. Jewellery must be removed for physical education lessons for health and safety reasons. Treorchy Comprehensive cannot be held responsible for the loss of any jewellery worn to school.

## HAIR, MAKE-UP AND NAILS / GWALLT, COLUR AC EWINEDD

Due to health and safety issues in practical subjects and for movement around the school, nails should be of a suitable length to allow students to fully participate in all learning activities. Hair needs to be safe and suitable for a work environment. Students may apply natural make-up if they wish to do so.



## PHYSICAL EDUCATION KIT GWISG ADDYSG GORFFOROL

- Black t-shirt
- Plain black ¾ zip long-sleeve top (optional)
- Black tracksuit/leggings
- Black shorts
- Trainers
- Football boots (as required for students to play football or rugby)
- Red or black rugby shirts (as required for students who are chosen to play rugby for the school/can also be used in lessons)
- Appropriate swimming clothing and swimming caps

Students with long hair must wear a swimming cap or tie their hair back when swimming.

### Uniform Suppliers / Cyflenwyr Gwisg Ysgol

The vast majority of school uniform for our school may be purchased from general suppliers such as high street stores, supermarkets or online shops. Some stores in our local area provide uniform that is specifically designed for the school.

### Health and Safety Considerations

Health and safety issues are extremely important and need to be given constant consideration, especially when students are taking part in practical lessons such as PE, science and technology. Students may be required to modify their school uniform to meet health and safety requirements. For example, we expect students with long hair or headscarves to tie them back safely for PE, work in science laboratories or technology workshops, where it would otherwise cause a risk to the student or other students and their surroundings.

### Uniform Grants / Grantiau Gwisg Ysgol

Clothing vouchers/grants may be available to students whose parents receive Income Support or Family Credit. Further details and application forms are available from school.

### Other Help / Cymorth Arall

The school has a 'uniform swap' which, in the summer term, encourages students to bring items of clean, usable uniform to school to pass on to other families.
